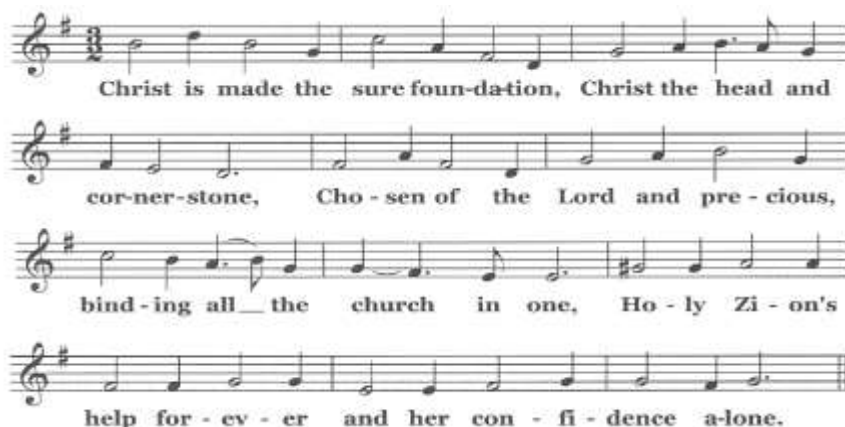

Julianne is a music instructor in the Indiana Area School District in Indiana, PA, where she currently serves as Director of Orchestras. A coloratura soprano, she has recently completed a sabbatical year, pursuing the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in voice performance at West Virginia University, studying with Dr. Hope Koehler. She formerly was a member of the professional core of the Mendelssohn Choir of Pittsburgh, performing regularly with the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra. She holds a Master of Music degree in voice performance from the University of Akron (1989) and a Bachelor of Music degree (1984) from Westminster College in New Wilmington, PA. She is the daughter of David and Nancy Laird, who also reside part-time in Kill Devil Hills and attend OBPC.

Julianne will present a concert consisting of the music of J.S. Bach, W.A. Mozart as well as spirituals.

Julianne will be accompanied by pianist, Yiwen Zhang. She has participated in various summer festivals, including the Orford Music Festival in Canada and the Perugia Festival in Italy. Yiwen is currently pursuing her Doctorate of Music Degree at West Virginia University. She holds a Master of Music degree in piano performance from the Boston Conservatory at Berklee and a Bachelors of Music degree from Peabody Conservatory.
